



REBIYA KADEER DEFENDING HUMAN RIGHTS IN **CHINA**

This is an opportunity to hear an inspirational human rights activist from China, working at great risk to defend her people, the Uighur, a turkic ethnic group, predominantly Muslim, from Xinjiang province.

The Uighur people suffer under a repressive administration in a similar way to the Tibetan people. Peaceful calls for self-determination and expressions of Uighur culture have been met with brutality including the death penalty, long periods of detention and torture.

Rebiya Kadeer, a businesswoman and campaigner for women, has spent time in prison and her children have suffered violently at the hands of the Chinese authorities.
